

Checklist for Authors

When submitting your article, attach this form to check that you have followed the Instruction to Authors by marking the Boxes next to each item where applicable. This is for both your convenience and ours – a manuscript that does not conform to the Instruction will be returned to the authors. Manuscripts should be sent only through the YOUNG website, <http://www.young.or.kr>

- Authors should carefully read the ‘Introductions to Authors’ at <http://www.young.or.kr> and make sure that the manuscript meets KAOA requirements.
- The Manuscript has not been published or is not being considered for publication in other journals.
- The Manuscript is typed in Hangul or Word with double-spaced (font size 12 points)
- The manuscript consisted of Title page, Abstract, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results (or Results and Discussion), Discussion, Acknowledgment, and Reference.
- The page must be numbered consecutively beginning with the title page.
- The title page should contain Title, Full author name, and Full postal address in Korean and English.
- Article type and a short running title of the article should be provided in title page.
- Abstract must be informative yet concise (no longer than 200 words), and prepared in English with three separate sections; BACKGROUND, METHODS AND RESULTS, and CONCLUSION(S).
- Key words should be provided immediately after the Abstract in alphabetical order (maximum 5 key words).
- The symbols and scales used in the text should be formatted as given in ‘Introductions to Authors’ at <http://www.young.or.kr>.
- All tables and figures should be submitted each as separate documents and in the acceptable format (see Instructions to Authors for details).
- The titles and legends of tables and figures should be written in English.
- All tables and figures must be referenced within the text.
- Figures should be prepared at the size of a single column of 80 mm wide or scheduled to be reduced to one column width.
- Acknowledgment should be written in English, and stated in a separate section the Reference.
- All reference (including electronic references) must be formatted according to the citation style described in the ‘Introductions to Authors’ at <http://www.young.or.kr>.
- References must be listed in alphabetical order and cited in the text.
- All references must be current and readily available to readers.
- Journal name should be abbreviated according to the ISI Science Citation Index database.
- The reports unpublished officially should not be listed in the Reference, but cited briefly only in the text.
